

# **Cleaning recommendations for Mehler Texnologies® products**

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- Select cleaning interval according to the degree of contamination.
- Contaminations should be removed as soon as possible in order to prevent material damage.
- Do not clean material with tools which might damage surfaces (e.g. high-pressure cleaner). Instead, use a towel, sponge or a soft brush.
- Use the recommended cleaning agents only.
- Apply cleaning agent only to the coated surface and avoid contact with the fabric.
- Store textile surfaces in a clean and dry state only.

## **CLEANING PROCESS**

- 1. Lightly brush off loose dirt particles first, then rinse material with clear water.
- 2. Spray on recommended cleaning agent in the indicated concentration or apply with a clean towel. Dose the amount according to degree of contamination.
- 3. Allow cleaning agent to act for a short while (2-5 minutes) and wipe off with a towel.
- 4. Rinse off dirt and cleaning agent residues thoroughly with cold or lukewarm water to prevent material discolorations.
- 5. Store material only if it is clean and completely dry.

#### **RECOMMENDED CLEANING AGENTS**

- As a rule, never use any solvent-containing or strong-alkaline cleaning agents.

  - → Apply the cleaning agent either in concentrated form or diluted 1:1 with water
- TentClean Green from Apco
- → Dilute cleaning agent 1:1 with water prior to use
- · Wet & Forget Outdoor Ready-to-Use from Wet and Forget Ltd
- Dilute cleaning agent 1:5 with water
- Planenreiniger 2 from WIEDS ECOCHEM AG
- → Dilute cleaning agent with water in a ratio of 1:5 to 1:20
- Mild Detergent (max. 5% detergent solution)
- → For products of the AIRTEX<sup>®</sup> and VALMEX<sup>®</sup> pacific ranges
- Hand-wash liquid soap
